Every 4 hours [420]	Desert Shield/Desert Storm deaths in theatre (1990-1991) [383]
Every day [2,500]	September 11, 2001 – Deaths from Terrorist Attacks on World Trade Center [2,819] ³ War of 1812 battle deaths (1812-1815) [2,260]
Every 2 days [5,000]	American Revolution battle deaths (1775-1783) [4,435]
Every 3 weeks [53,000]	World War I battle deaths in theatre (1917-1918) [53,402]
Every 3 weeks [53,000]	Vietnam War battle/other deaths in theatre (1964-1975) [58,230]
Every 16 weeks [282,000]	World War II battle deaths in theatre (1941-1945) [291,557]
Every 6 months [458,000]	Civil War total Union & Confederate war deaths in theatre (1861-1865) [498,332]
Every year (2015) [915,000]	ALL WARS: total battle & other deaths in theatre (1775-2010) [984,142]
